

Beginner Cat by Janice Blair

Handy Hands Lizbeth 20 (Hobby Lobby)

10 pairs wound with approx. 24" each bobbin continuously.

Cloth Stitch (CS) – Cross Twist Cross

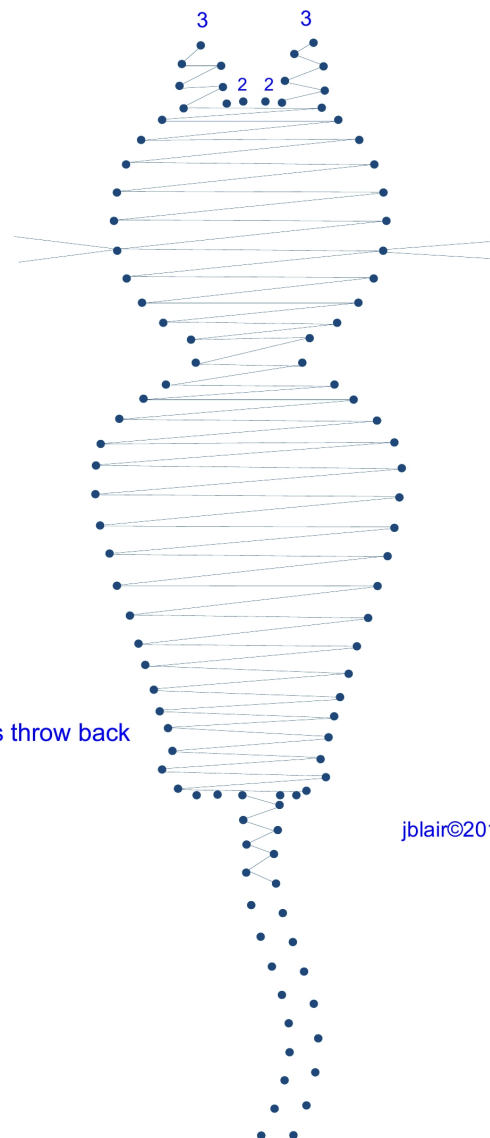
Half Stitch (HS) – Cross Twist

Whole Stitch (WS)- Cross Twist Cross Twist


Pair – (pr) Passive Pair (ps)

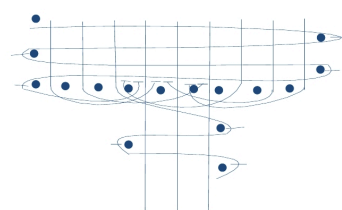
Worker – (wkr)

Hang 3 prs on first ear. Twist together.
Cloth stitch right pr (wkr) left to next pin.
Twist wkr pr once, work across to next pin.
Continue down to bottom of ear, ending on right side.
Place support pin to left of right passive pr & wkr.
Hang 2 prs on next 2 pins. CS wkr through them.
Hang 3 prs on other ear and work down to bottom of ear as before, placing pin under that wkr.
Take original wkr through to end of row, working WS stitch with last pr. (ctctpinctct)
Twist all prs once to begin half stitch (HS).
Work each row in HS and at the pin on each end work a WS pin WS. Notice that your wkr will change on each row. The passives will now go in diagonal directions. Check that you have a twist on each pr before starting the next row, and tension each row. Work down to the last two rows and change to CS. At the bottom you will have to discard 3 prs on each side and work the tail with 4 prs. Follow the diagram.



 Dash on line is a twist

 Dash at end of line means throw back a pair and cut off later



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
